A comprehensive discussion on batting choices, basting for hand quilting, marking and traditional design choices as well as the rocking stitch will be shared. Many of Darlene's quilts will be shared and discussed – round table style. An easy method of Trapunto will be demonstrated. Some marking will be practiced while some will be prepared ahead to save time.

SUPPLIES NEEDED: 14" round wooden [or plastic] quilting hoop, thimble [raised end recommended], Clover brand Hera Marking Tool, 24" L x 6" W [approx.] cutting ruler, one spool YLI brand ecru color hand quilting thread, Mid-sized to small cutting mat, small sharp thread scissors.

PROVIDED: 2 – 18" squares of solid fabric [stenciling is marked] 2- 18" squares of Pellon Legacy Wool batting, a quilting needle. Some supplies will be available for use in class.
